Also, wedges are used with full swings and, more often than not, with less than full swings. They are used for chipping, pitching and bunker shots.

Wedges provide the best opportunity to birdie short par 4s and most par 5s yet are heavily relied upon for par-saving recovery shots.

Wedges must take on major responsibilities (equaling the putter) when it comes to lowering scores.

The impact-area punch marks are arranged so that golfers can calibrate added loft when opening the face for a higher trajectory, shorter distance shot.

The first question often asked is:
Is the face legal?

Yes – the USGA rules regarding face markings are very specific and Numba Wedge face markings are designed well within the rules.

The USGA restricts face markings to either grooves, punch marks, or a combination of grooves and punch marks.

The milled grooves on Numba Wedges are the recently instituted Condition of Competition (C.C.) grooves and the milled punch marks are within the USGA's diameter, depth and spacing requirements.

We recognize that the unique and proprietary face design of Numba Wedges is the most obvious difference between us and established brands of wedges.

However, the second concept, and in concert with our innovative design, is a completely new way of marketing, service and delivery, which is receiving rave reviews from our customers.

Instead of searching through racks of pre-built wedges that are largely one length, offer just one shaft, one grip size and mostly even-numbered lofts, **Numba** defies convention by delivering custom fit wedges in minutes, not days or weeks.

Fitting/Completing Procedure

Prior to completing and delivering wedges that match and transition from your existing irons, **Numba** establishes the dimensions and specifications of your current iron set, especially your PW.

- 1: Measure the loft of your PW
- 2: Measure the shaft length of your PW
- 3: Measure the lie angle of your PW
- 4: Establish the flex of your shafts
- 5: Establish the weight of your shafts
- 6: Establish the size of your grips

Numba’s on-site inventory is untrimmed and un-gripped, includes two shaft weights plus all lofts encompassing MW, SW and LW models.

With the above information **Numba** selects the appropriate model, loft and shaft, trims to the correct length and installs the correct sized grip.

Prefer your own grips? We can trim to length but leave your wedges un-gripped.

No waiting! Instead of days or weeks, your **Numba** wedges are delivered within minutes.
